Fees cover Cub Scout for 5 days, 1 T-Shirt, Patch, water bottle, and program supplies. Meals are **NOT** included.

Cub Scout Day Camp Refund Policy

All Scouts who are unable to attend Day Camp for any reason will receive a refund less a \$50.00 cancellation fee. All refund requests need to be filled out on a Camp Fee Refund Request form and submitted to the Council Camping Secretary. All Day Camp refunds must be submitted to the Council Office within 1 week of the end of your registered camp. Refunds will not be processed after this deadline

2019 Day Camp Volunteer Requirement

Each Pack which sends Scouts to Day Camp will be required to provide at least 1 adult for every 5 scouts in attendance. The adult will be eligible for the Volunteer Discount Price for their children.

☺ **All scouts, family members, and Staff need an Annual Health and Medical Record part A & B. Scouts and Leaders who are attending Cub Scout Day Camp must complete Parts A& B of the Annual Medical Record. Forms available on line at: www.bpcouncil.org. DO NOT mail the health forms to the Council Office! Bring them with you on the first day of Day Camp. (Any special dietary/health needs must be submitted to the Baden Powell Council Office prior to Day Camp.**

Registration

Registration will be accepted online, by mail, fax, or in person at the Baden-Powell Council Service Center, 2150 NYS Route 12 Binghamton, NY 13901. Fax 607-648-7895 no telephone registrations will be accepted but questions will be answered by calling 607-648-7888 ask for the camping department. Online registration will be available at bpcouncil.org and going to the camping page. Once at the camping page click on the Cub Scout Day Camp online registration link on the left hand side of the page.

Non Registered Scouts

If your child is not a registered Cub Scout and meet the age requirements, you must complete the application to join a Cub Scout Pack and pay the application fee of \$39.00. This fee includes the Sickness and Accidental Insurance.

Lunch

Each child must provide their own nonperishable lunch, brown bag style, unless otherwise noted in Day Camp Welcome Letter. It is strongly recommended not to use mayonnaise or other products needing refrigeration as no refrigeration is available.

What to Wear to Camp

Each child will receive one T-Shirt with paid registration and must be worn to camp each day as the shirt is a security feature. Additional shirts can be bought during the registration period. Socks and Shoes are required in all program areas except waterfront areas where water shoes are optional.
